F. Charging by LIRs

- There's been almost no discussion on the ripe-152bis mailing list (just eight messages). There are three possible alternative courses of action.
- Either we could decide that there really wasn't much interest in updating the document and decide to leave it be;
- or we could decide to mark it as "historical";
- or we could ask for volunteers to form an editorial group and commit to producing a draft update within \$time. That draft could then be published and reviewed by everyone else.

F. Chargeing by LIRs – next step:

I think no action is not acceptable:

- "while registries may charge for their administrative and technical services, they may not charge for **name space** or address space as such; no unit cost or price tag can be attached to a domain name or to an IP address, public or private."
- and while we may want to remove domain names we might want to add AS Numbers. (?)
