

Update on the IETF CRISP Working Group

RIPE 47

New Charter

- The CRISP working group has approved a new charter (and appropriate milestones).
- These changes incorporate new work items to cover requirements and protocol design relating to Number Resource Registries (I.e. RIR's).

Current Work Items

- IRIS core and domain registry drafts are currently undergoing editing for readability and correctness.
- Expect these drafts to go to working group last call very soon (the new milestones say January).

New Work Items

- According to new milestones:
 - New requirements document (incorporating the old requirements and the new requirements for Number Resource Registries) to be submitted by March.
 - New IRIS address registry (areg) draft to be submitted by June.

New Proposals

- UDP transport
 - A new, lightweight UDP transport for IRIS has been proposed.

 - There are nickname/whois usage statistics that suggest this type of transport would be beneficial.
 - Some working group participants want to see CRISP accomplish its current milestones first.
 - This is not a working group item, yet.
