E. AfriNIC: Status & Transition proposal

(Ernest Byaruhanga, AfriNIC)

- ☐ Change initial allocation from /22 to /23 for LIRs in Africa
- ☐ Reason
 - ☐ Allow easy access to Internet resources in Africa
- ☐ Discussion
 - ☐ As there is no criteria to get a /22 in the RIPE NCC service region the need for this change is not as critical as it was in regions with a 50% utilization rule.
- ☐ Action:

F. Chargeing by LIRs RIPE 152

Reason for topic:

- "while registries may charge for their administrative and technical services, they may not charge for **name space** or address space as such; no unit cost or price tag can be attached to a domain name or to an IP address, public or private."
- Task force have discussed the matter
