- Reason
  - ☐ Allow easy access to Internet resources in Africa

  - ☐ As there is no criteria to get a /22 in the RIPE NCC service region the need for this chage is not as critical as it was in regions with a 50% utilization rule.

- "while registries may charge for their administrative and technical services, they may not charge for name space or address space as such; no unit cost or price tag can be attached to a domain name or to an IP address, public or private."
- Task force have discussed the matter
