  - Some worries about speed of achieving consensus
  - Availability of clients?
  - Please read the IETF drafts and get involved!
  - Potential to define unified view of the registry datasets!
- Remove **auth: NONE**
  - Consensus
  - Will be implemented very soon
  - Without warning (for security reasons)
